PROGRAMMES IN THE INSTITUTE OF HEALTH AND ALLIED SCIENCES

* **Ordinary Diploma in Medical Laboratory Sciences (DMLS) – NTA LEVEL 6**

This is a competency based six-semester Diploma in Medical Laboratory Sciences (DMLS) Programme. It intends to train health personnel capable of managing medical laboratory and diagnostic services focusing on preventive curative and rehabilitative health care. Students are also trained to carry out research activities relevant to provision of quality health in laboratory services.

Entry Requirements

Holders of Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (CSEE) with at least Four (4) passes ('D' grade) in non-religious subjects including; D in Chemistry, D in Biology and D in Physics/Engineering Sciences. A pass ('D' grade) in Basic Mathematics and English Language is an added advantage.

Programme Duration – 3 Years

* **Ordinary Diploma in Medical Laboratory (Upgrading) – NTA Level 6**

Holders of Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (CSEE) with five (5) passes in non-religious subjects including "D" passes in Chemistry, Biology, and Physics/Engineering Sciences **PLUS** holders of Technician Certificate in Medical laboratory Sciences (NTA level 5) from a NACTE recognized Institution

* Ordinary Diploma in Pharmaceutical Sciences (DPS) – NTA LEVEL 6

This is a competency based six-semester Diploma in Pharmaceutical Science (DPS) Programme. It is intended to train competent Pharmaceutical technician who can manage a district or a health care centre pharmacy under the supervision of a registered pharmacist. The training mainly focuses on imparting knowledge and skills to students on compounding and dispensing drugs to in-patient and outpatients in the health facilities. Also students are trained on providing drug related information to patients and the public at large.

Entry Requirements

Holders of Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (CSEE) with at least Four (4) passes ('D' grade) in non-religious subjects including; D in Chemistry and D in Biology.

Programme Duration – 3 Years

* Ordinary Diploma in Pharmaceutical Sciences (Upgrading) – NTA Level 6

Holders of Certificate of Secondary Education Examination (CSEE) with four (4) passes "D" in non-religious subjects including Chemistry and Biology **PLUS** must possess Technician Certificate in Pharmaceutical sciences (NTA Level 5) from a NACTE recognized Institution

Programme Duration – 1 Year

APPLICATION PROCEDURE:

1. All applications shall be processed and submitted online through a portal (Online Application System - OAS) accessible on SFUCHAS website (<https://www.sfuchas.ac.tz/>).
2. Please, follow instructions given to complete your application.
3. Applications submitted in hard copies shall not be processed.

APPLICATION FEE (Non-refundable):

Application fee is 20,000/= TZs for Tanzanian applicants paid to the University. This can be paid via **mobile money (M-Pesa, Tigo Pesa and Airtel Money) or directly into SFUCHAS bank account (CRDB Bank Branch/Agent/SimBanking App/SimBanking USSD)** using the provided control number.
